

PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON ASHMEAD ROAD AND ADJOINING ROAD JUNCTIONS

Reason for proposal: Bedford Borough Council has received a request to address inconsiderate parking at road junctions on Ashmead Road. Consequently access for larger vehicles such as buses and emergency vehicles is restricted in addition to the poor visibility at the junction.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce ‘no waiting at anytime’ restrictions on the following lengths of road:

Ashmead Road, Bedford

(i)	On both sides of the road (main road junction east of Russet Close and Gala Close and north of Tydeman Close) extending a distance approximately 18.5 metres in a western direction and 20 metres in an eastern direction from its junction with Ashmead Road
(ii)	On both sides of the road (fronting 66 and to the side of 69 Ashmead Road) extending a distance approximately 14 metres in a southern direction from its junction with Ashmead Road
(iii)	On both sides of the road extending a distance approximately 14 metres in a western direction from its junction with Ashmead Road (section of road fronting no.58)
(iv)	On both sides of the road covering the section between the main arterial road and Tydeman Close
(v)	On both sides of the road (to the side of 2 Laxton Way and fronting 101 Ashmead Road) extending a distance approximately 15 metres in a southern direction from its junction with Ashmead Road
(vi)	On its northern kerb (between the junctions of Crispin Drive and Laxton Way) extending a distance approximately 12.5 metres in a western direction and 16 metres in an eastern direction from its junction with Ashmead Road
(vii)	On its southern kerb (between the junctions of Crispin Drive and Laxton Way) extending a distance approximately 16 metres in both an eastern and western direction from its junction with Ashmead Road
(viii)	On both sides of the road extending a distance approximately 11.5 metres in a southern direction from its junction with Margil Road

Tydeman Close, Bedford

(i)	On its most northern kerb extending a distance approximately 24 metres in an eastern direction AND on its most southern kerb extending a distance approximately 10.5 metres in an eastern direction from its junction with Ashmead Road

Sturmer Road

(i)	On both sides of the road extending a distance approximately 10.5 metres in an eastern direction from its junction with Ashmead Road (this includes a short length of yellow lines on Ashmead Road as this junction)
(ii)	On both sides of the road extending a distance approximately 13 metres in a western direction from its junction with Crispin Drive

Crispin Drive

(i)	On both sides of the road extending a distance approximately 10 metres in a northern direction from its junction with Ashmead Road
(ii)	On its western kerb extending a distance approximately 9.5 metres in a northern direction AND 8.5 metres in a southern direction from its junction with Sturmer Road
(iii)	On its western kerb extending a distance approximately 8 metres in a northern direction AND 9 metres in a southern direction from its junction with Margil Road

Margil Road

(i)	On both sides of the road extending a distance approximately 10 metres in a western direction from its junction with Crispin Drive
(ii)	On its most southern extending a distance approximately 36 metres in an eastern direction from its junction with Ribston Close

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Bedford Borough Council has received a request from the Ward Councillors for Great Barford Ward requesting that parking restrictions are installed at various road junctions of Ashmead Road estate. It has been observed that vehicles frequently park on the road junction making access/egress at the junction difficult and also severely reducing visibility at the road junction. In particular, buses have found it difficult to access the full estate due to the manner in which vehicles are parked.

Junctions should remain clear of parked vehicles to enable safe access/egress and ensure that good visibility is maintained at all times. The Council is satisfied that sufficient off street parking is provided to residents and that much on-street parking is still maintained within the vicinity of the proposed parking restrictions.
